Hashinger is a co-educational hall housing 400 students, mostly upper level students. This hall is the Center for Creative Arts, and provides extra facilities for those students who are interested in many forms of the arts. Any student interested in any phase of the arts regardless of formal academic program may enjoy the Hashinger experience. Hashinger residents develop strong group unity within the hall while coming together to create and share hobbies and interests. Hashinger provides an opportunity for feedback and skill improvement for students proficient in the arts, as well as for those students who are just beginning.

Facilities in the hall include: a crafts room, music practice rooms, painting and drawing rooms, a photo darkroom, pottery and ceramics equipment, sewing machines and several weaving looms, a weight-lifting room and room equipped for woodworking and sculpture. Other facilities are a dance and exercise room, a library, a showcase in which students display their work, a drafting room, and a small theater.

Hashinger staff and residents use these facilities for producing plays and musicals, teaching pottery classes, musical recitals, dance classes and much more. The Hashinger Hall Resident Theater travels to other halls with plays, and resident artists present varied programs and workshops while living in the hall.
